How to find us

Salford Museum and Art Gallery is situated on the Crescent (A6) at the front of the University of Salford campus. Chapman Gallery will be signposted from Salford Museum and Art Gallery; it is a short walk between the two venues.

By Car: The Museum is easily reached from the Greater Manchester motorway network. From the north, leave the M60 at Junction 13 (A666) or, from the south, follow the signs from the end of the M602. Follow signs on the A6, the Museum is the turning after Salford Crescent Railway station. If approaching along the A6 westbound from Manchester City Centre travel for approximately 5 minutes onto the Crescent. Pass the University on your right and take the left turning for the Salford Crescent railway station. Follow the road to a mini roundabout, taking the 3rd exit onto the A6 eastbound and take the next road on the left into the University campus.

By Bus: Buses from Manchester, Bolton, Swinton and Eccles stop outside the Museum on the Crescent (A6). Bus numbers: 7, 8, 12, 26, 31, 32, 36, 37, 67, 68, 100, X34, X61

By Train: Salford Crescent railway station is only five minutes from both venues.
